## THE SCHOOL

Thanks be to God for the successful graduation of the second batch of students from the Southeast School of Bible Studies. The graduation protocols were as follows:

(Banquet is held in honor of our graduates. At this time, students express gratitude to their parents, supporters etc. etc.)

3. Baccalaureate service and commencement day..Sunday, May 26th.

The school initially enrolled 7 students, but four made it to graduation. Out of the four, three attended the commencement ceremony. One couldn't because of unforeseen circumstances. Thanks to y'all for your immense support.

## PRESENT STATE OF THE SCHOOL

We have created an opportunity for our brethren who are working class individuals. This affords them the chance to receive the biblical education we offer. There are 7 students in the Saturday section.

Nevertheless, after the first quarter there was additional recruitment of campus students (those who live on campus). Three of them are presently on campus while we await one more next week.

Total number of students for academic 2024 - 2026 are 11 students.

We are looking forward to the day when the school would at least afford additional support for evangelism. There is a greater potential for growth of the school provided we could reach out to the people at least on a quarterly basis.

## THE CHURCH

The Zwedru congregation is constructing its edifice which is capable of hosting 150 seats.

Moreover, there are additional rooms attached to the edifice, such as children's class, office for "would be" elders and deacons, a minister's office, and Bathrooms.

Through the school, SESBS, there were 10 baptisms at a newly established congregation. Out of those that were baptized, three are students at the school.
